Delightful blend of pinot Noir and garnatxa. Aromas of herbs and fresh flowers, bright notes of perfectly fresh red fruits, complex yet refreshing.

<i>Columbia Valley, Washington</i>			
Aromatic with scents of peach, pear and apple. Delicious with a lighter body leaning heavily into citrus, apple and pear flavors. Refreshingly delicious!

Rosé of Syrah bursting with fresh grapefruit, bright acidity and mineral notes, hints of blood orange, cranberries, geranium, crisp balanced finish.			
Krasno, Orange	6	11	39
<i>Brda, Slovenia</i>			
Aromas of Quince, ripe pear and hints of thyme. Gentle and sweet tannins with fresh, and lasting aftertaste rounded with roasted almonds.			
Angelo Negro, Brachetto	8	14	49
<i>Piedmont, Italy</i>			
Bright, fresh aromatic cherry coupled with delicate hints of violet and rose. A pleasantly tart wine with notes of candied red fruit on the palate.			

Fall-ing for White Wine – 15

<i>Tuscany, Italy</i>			
Intense aromas or ripe summer fruit, lemon undertones and cooked apple, lingering tingle of acid and long pleasant finish that begs for a second sip.			
A'Telleria, Godello PS	7	13	45
<i>Riberio, Spain</i>			
Fragrant grapefruit and quince bouquet with hints of lime zest. Flavors of ruby grapefruit, quince blend with notes of crushed stone minerality.			
Pequenos Rebentos, Alvarinho V, S	8	15	52
<i>Vinho Verde, Portugal</i>			
Lime leaf and mineral notes on the nose, fleshy citrus fruits, with a touch of vegetal notes on the palate. Palate cleansing crisp acidity and tangy finish!

Melon and banana peel on the nose, mature peach and apricot on the palate with a touch of minerality. The way pinot grigio is meant to be!			
Fogscape Vineyards, Chardonnay	7	13	45
<i>Arroyo Seco, California</i>			
Rich and opulent wine, stone fruit pits, tropical fruit hints of coconut and sweet vanilla. flavors of buttered toast, citrus, white peach and pineapple			
Joyce Vineyards, Chardonnay W	8	15	52
<i>Submarine Canyon (Monterey), California</i>			
Juicy peach and daffodil on the nose, subtle notes of almond and lemon. Full flavored with yellow apple, citrus, banana and medium acid

Slight peach and apricot on the nose, loads of dried lemon peel and touch of petrol aromas, bright rays of balanced acid and notes of honey on palate

Intense aromas of sweet ripe limes and kiwifruit. pineapple, citrus blossom and lime zest on the palate, juicy acid and bright mineral notes on finish.

Aromas and flavors of dried herbs, spices, red cherries, and hints of oak. Well balanced by its grip and acidity. A Cali pinot noir through and through.

Blend of merlot, cab and cab franc. Aromas of red fruit and blackcurrant alongside floral overtones reminiscent of violet.

Fresh and fruity, aromas of red fruits and floral touches predominate over a background of wild and mountain herbs, balanced and ripe tannins.

Cassis and red-plum aromas. Medium-bodied with firm, fine-grained tannins and generous red fruit. Remains balanced and food friendly enough.

100% cabernet sauvignon, laser focused with harmonious structure, baked blueberry, maple candies, black olives and eucalyptus flavors and aromas
